Reintroduction of the Sign of Peace

Parishioners are reminded of the protocols of good hygiene: being aware and sensitive to sneezing, coughing and colds.

If you have cold or flu it may be best to stay at home until you are better.

No person should feel obliged or compelled to offer a handshake.

So it is suggested that some form of greeting be expressed, whether it be a bow, a nod, a smile or a handshake but **only** with the person on your immediate left and right with the greeting: "Peace be with you" and **not to those**behind or in front of you.
